Helping Parents Help Their Kids Adjust to Divorce

Parents are forever. Although parents can divorce each other, their *children are not divorceable*. Each parent is responsible for nurturing and creating their children's sense of security and well-being – even through the divorce process. *Focus on Kids* was designed to help you with that task.

The goal of *Focus on Kids* is for parents to better understand how divorce affects children and how their actions during and after the divorce can have long-term effects on the children involved.

What will I gain?

After attending *Focus On Kids*, which is only two and one-half hours long, you will:

- ◆ Understand the importance of ongoing, supportive and nurturing involvement by both parents.
- ◆ Receive information on both children's and adolescents' developmental needs, abilities and common reactions to divorce.
- ◆ Learn specific behaviors that help in a co-parenting situation and those that should be avoided.
- ◆ Receive information on community resources.

How do I register?

Pre-registration is required for each parent. A \$35 per-person fee, payable by **cash** or **money order** to University Extension, can be paid in advance, or immediately prior to the start of class.

To reschedule: Call the Livingston County Extension Office by noon the day before you are registered to attend.

What else do I need to know?

- ◆ You and the other parent need to attend on separate dates.
- ◆ Childcare is not provided so children are not allowed to attend.
- ◆ Sign-in and sign-out is required. Plan to arrive 10 minutes early and to stay for the entire two and one-half hour session.
- ◆ Attendance is confirmed after you have completed a session. The facilitator will send verification to the Circuit Clerk.
