- Obtain information on children's and adolescent's developmental needs and common reactions to divorce.
- Learn about specific behaviors that are helpful in a co-parenting situation and behaviors that should be avoided.
- Receive additional information on community resources.



## PARENTS ARE FOREVER

Going through a divorce is often painful and stressful for parents AND children. Although parents can divorce each other, children are not divorceable.

**From I-70**

Take Hwy 65 north for 10 miles into Marshall. When you approach Marshall, you will continue north onto Business 65. At this point, 65 will become Odell Ave. Continue north on Odell through a stop light (College Street), then to a four-way stop (Yerby Street) and continue north 4 blocks—You will then turn left at Washington Street and go 2 blocks, to the corner of Lafayette. The Extension Office is located on the southwest corner of Lafayette & Washington street intersection.


